System Manager Information

Department Abbreviation (lowest level)		Required. A HARF completed letter will be mailed to you when processing of this form is complete. We need a complete campus mail address.
System User		Name of the person who uses or owns this system (i.e., in whose office is the computer located).

Computer Information

Hostname		Stays with system and will not be changed. Select name so moving locations or changing owners is not a problem.
Bldg Rm/Pt		Use ISIS building abbreviation only (kept on file, notify Information Networks if a system changes buildings) and full room number (used only for installation).
Phone		Telephone number that is closest to the system.
Mfg		Manufacturer of System - e.g. gw2000, dell, ibm, gateway
Model		Manufacturer Name and System Model Number. This can be a real model number or system class - e.g. 486DX2-66, P5-800, 2.3G
OS		The basic operating system in use - e.g., win2000, winME, lynx, solaris, linux, XP, etc.
MAC Address		Provide the Ethernet Interface MAC Address. Provide 12 HEX DIGITS with a colon between each pair.
